J. Walker Field Scholarship Guidelines

- Scholarships to be one-time awards in the amount of \$1,000.
- Maximum number of scholarships available are determined by current year's budget.
- Awarding process to be done by Scholarship Committee.
- Applicants Must:
 1. Complete the current year official FKF application and send to the address provided. Application must be **received** no later than **March 1st of the current application year**. Emailed applications are acceptable as noted on form.
 2. Be a graduating high school senior within the Florida District.
 3. Have a GPA of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale, unweighted.
 4. Be a current dues paid member of Key Club International and the Florida District of Key Club for a minimum of 2 school years.
 5. Have been accepted to an accredited College or University within the Florida District. Recipients will also have to attend said College or University within the Florida District.
 6. Have performed at least **150** service hours within the years that they have been in Key Club. Hours must qualify as **SLP / Kiwanis related service** and be verified by School or Kiwanis Advisor.
 7. Complete essay questions per application.
- Grading and award of scholarships to be performed by FKF Scholarship Committee. Based on:
 - GPA
 - Total number of reported Service Hours
 - Quality of service hours and service above the club level, including Division and / or District leadership positions. (ie: LTG, Division project chairs, etc.)
 - Answers to the questions per essay on application.
- Scholarships will be awarded / announced at the Florida District of Key Club Annual Convention, if possible.
- Awarded scholarships will be paid directly to the recipient in August of the qualifying year upon proof of registration as a full-time student.
- Applicant is eligible for only one (1) Foundation Scholarship in any given year.
- All scholarship winners will be required to complete a Consent / Release Form so their information may, or may not, be published by the Foundation.
